You can support the preservation and documentation of SA Church history by becoming a member of the Uniting Church SA Historical Society.

Members are kept up to date with information about publications and resources through the Society's newsletter *Uniting History SA* which is published four times a year. Each year the Society organises various events to highlight history connected to the Uniting Church and its former denominations.

Members are invited to visit the History Centre on Wednesday afternoons to ask for advice or find information about churches, agencies, former ministers, members and local communities.

The Society also provides financial assistance to authors planning to publish stories of congregations, agencies and movements of the Uniting Church and its former denominations.

The Uniting Church SA Historical Society is associated with the Uniting Church National History Society (UCNHS), a body established by the Assembly in 2016 to promote interest in and preservation of Uniting Church History. Membership of the national society is \$20 per year, and you are invited to join as you join/renew membership in UC SA Historical Society.

The society's collection of historical and archival material is housed at the History Centre, 44A East Avenue, Black Forest, 5035 and is open on Wednesday afternoons from 1:00pm to 4:00pm.

The aims of the Society include

- Promote the collection, preservation and exhibition of historical documents and records;
- Preserve and store the artefacts and documents which are not required by the Synod to be lodged at the State Library of South Australia;
- Promote the study and discussion of the history of the Uniting Church particularly in South Australia and of the three churches existing prior to union;
- Publish historical articles and lectures;
- Share historical information through lectures, workshops, etc.;
- Co-operate with other societies interested in South Australian history and/or the history of the Uniting Church and the bodies from which it was formed.

The information gathered on this form will be stored and used in ways compliant with the Society's Privacy Policy. We collect this information as part of our membership records and in order to keep you informed about the news and events of the Society.
